大葉大學外國學生獎助學金審查辦法

適用112-1(含)後入學學生

- 外國學生獎助學金分為博士班、碩士班及學士班共三個不同學制進行審查。
- 獎助學金申請資格說明:
 - 1. 申請人須完成當學期之註冊後,始具申請獎助學金資格。
 - 2. 申請人申請獎助學金前一學期操行分數須達80分以上,始具申請獎助學金資格。
 - 申請人為非華語系統國家學生(碩士及學士學位生),且就讀於全英語授課之系所,自入 學第三學期起(含)需通過CEFR語言能力參考指標A2(含)以上或其他中文檢定同級證明, 始具申請獎助學金資格。
 - 申請人(學士學位生)須提供服務學習十小時之證明,並經國際暨兩岸交流處蓋章後,始 具申請獎助學金資格。
- 申請人休/退/轉/復學相關說明:
 - 申請人獲得獎助學金補助後,如該學期具休退轉學之情事,則當學期所獲得之獎助學金需 全數退還,否則未來復學後將不具申請獎助學金資格。
 - 2. 申請人復學當學期不具申請獎助學金資格。
- 獎助學金核發金額:
 第一級:當年度公告之一學期學雜費金額,另加助學金新台幣四萬元(限博士學位生申請)¹。
 第二級:當年度公告之一學期學雜費金額(博士、碩士及學士學位生皆可申請)。
 第三級:當年度公告之一學期學雜費總金額的二分之一(博士、碩士及學士學位生皆可申請)。
- 期刊、研討會論文發表注意事項:
 - 期刊、研討會論文發表之通訊作者需為本校之指導教授,且獎學金申請人需為第一作者, 該論文得符合獎助學金申請之要件。
 - 承上,如該論文之發表為共同第一作者,則申請人須額外檢附「論文共同發表放棄申請獎 助學金聲明書」,請詳見附件一。
 - 發表之論文務必投稿於國內外學術期刊(Academic Journals),若投稿於掠奪性期刊 (Predatory Journals)²,則視為不符合申請之要件。
 - 承上,即使同學投稿之期刊並未載於掠奪性期刊名單之中,但只要該期刊符合掠奪性期刊 之特徵,經獎助學金審查委員會認定,則該著作就不符合獎助學金申請之要件。
 - 5. 學術論文發表點數計算如下:
 - (1) 發表於 SCI、SSCI、A&HCI 收錄期刊每篇為2點。
 - (2) 發表於 SCI、SSCI、A&HCI 收錄期刊,且期刊領域排名為前 25%3者每篇為 3 點。
 - (3) 發表於 SCI、SSCI、A&HCI 收錄期刊,且期刊領域排名為前 10%者每篇為4點。
 - (4) 發表於 ESCI、EI、TSSCI、FLI、ECONLIT 或 THCI 收錄期刊每篇為1點。
 - (5)發表於申請日前一學期所舉辦之研討會之論文,國內研討會每篇為 0.5 點,國際研討 會每篇為1點。每篇研討會論文申請人一人為上限。
- 其他未盡事項,獎助學金審查委員有權做最終解釋與決定。

Da-Yeh University Principles for International Students Scholarship

For students who enroll after Fall Semester, 2023

- The International students' scholarship is divided into the following categories: doctoral, master's, and bachelor's degree programs.
- Scholarship eligibility criteria explanation:
 - 1. Applicants must be registered, i.e., complete payment of the tuition fees for the current semester, to be eligible to apply for the scholarship.
 - 2. Applicants must have obtained a conducting score of 80 or above in the previous semester to be eligible to apply for the scholarship.
 - 3. Non-Chinese-speaking international students (master's and bachelor's degree students) enrolled in English-taught programs, starting from their third semester of study (inclusive), must have achieved a minimum CEFR language proficiency level of A2 or equivalent certification in Chinese proficiency to be eligible to apply for the scholarship.
 - 4. Applicants (bachelor's degree students) must provide proof of completing ten hours of service learning, verified by the Office of International Affairs, to be eligible to apply for the scholarship.
- Explanation regarding Leave of Absence/Withdrawal/Transfer/Resumption of Studies for Applicants:
 - 1. If an applicant receives scholarship funding and experiences a situation of taking a leave of absence, withdrawal, or transfer during the same semester, the scholarship received for that semester must be fully refunded. Failure to do so will result in the loss of eligibility for future scholarship applications upon resumption of studies.
 - 2. Applicants are not eligible to apply for a scholarship during the semester they resume their studies.
- The levels of the scholarship are as follows: Class 1: Full - tuition fees and incidental fees for one semester and awarded an additional NT\$ 40,000 (applicable to new Ph.D. students only)⁴. Class 2: Full - tuition fees and incidental fees for one semester (applicable to all students).

Class 3: Half - tuition fees, incidental fees for one semester (applicable to all students).

Class 5: Hall - tuttion fees, incluental fees for one semester (applicable to all stud

- Guidelines for the publications on journal and conference papers:
 - 1. For journal and conference papers, the corresponding author must be the supervising professor at Da-Yeh university. In addition, scholarship applicants must be the first authors of the documents.
 - 2. If the applicant is the co-first author listed on the paper, an additional "declaration for withdrawing the application for the Scholarship as the Co-First Author of the Journal Paper Publication" should also be submitted. Please refer to Appendix A for more details.
 - 3. The published paper must be submitted to reputable domestic or international academic journals. If offered to predatory journals⁵, it will be considered as failing to meet the requirements for application.
 - 4. If the journal to which the student submits the paper is not listed as a predatory journal, the performance will be deemed ineligible for scholarship application if the journal exhibits characteristics of predatory journals as determined by the Scholarship Review Committee.
 - 5. The calculation of publication points is as follows:
 - (1) Each journal publication indexed in SCI, SSCI, and A&HCI is awarded 2 points.
 - (2) Each journal publication indexed in SCI, SSCI, and A&HCI, with a category ranking in the top 25%⁶, is awarded 3 points per paper.
 - (3) Each journal publication indexed in SCI, SSCI, and A&HCI, with a category ranking in the top 10%, is awarded 4 points per paper.

- (4) Each journal publication indexed in ESCI, EI, TSSCI, FLI, ECONLIT, or THCI is awarded 1 point per paper.
- (5) Each paper presented at conferences held in the semester before the application date is awarded
 0.5 points for domestic conferences and 1 point for international conferences only one applicant per conference paper.
- Any other matters not covered in the above guidelines are subject to the final interpretation and decision of the Scholarship Review Committee.

Applicants must meet the scholarship application criteria outlined in the "Regulations for Reviewing Foreign Student Scholarships" and satisfy the qualification requirements listed in this table to be eligible for the related scholarships.
