Undergraduate admissions regulation, Department of Bioresources, DaYehUniversity

- 1. These regulations are formulated in accordance with the main regulation of the university's admissions.
- 2. "Individual application for admission" refers to the candidate enrolled in the annual academic ability and technical examination, and the scores passed the screening criteria of the university. After being admitted to the university, the candidates will register for the volunteer order and distribute the admission method.
- 3. These requirements are reviewed by the Department's Admissions Committee, and the relevant selection methods, procedures and scoring regulations are set out and handled carefully after being announced in the school.
- 4. In accordance with these requirements, the individual application for admission to the school shall be handled in accordance with the principles of just, fairness and openness, and the relevant confidentiality and avoidance principles shall be carefully formulated.
- 5. Enrollment quotas: After being decided by the department meeting, they shall be sent to the relevant conferences of the school for deliberation and then reported to the Ministry of Education for approval.
- 6. Qualifications for Applicants: Those who meet the qualifications stipulated in the University's Admission and Admission System for the Year of Admission as set by the College Admissions Committee may apply.
- 7. The Procedure:

The first stage (subject ability test): Those who pass the screening criteria of this department can participate in the second phase of the designated project test, which accounts for 20% of the total score of the test. The second stage (designated project test): The interview in this department account for 80% of the total scores.

- 8. The second phase of the designated project test method: Interview: This item accounts for 80% of the total scores. The scores include overall performance (50%), development potential (30%), and the logic thinking (20%).
- 9. The selection regulation order for the same total scores Eco-Operation and Biodiversity Group: Interview, natural science ability test, and national language ability test.

Medical microbiology group: interview, natural science ability test, national language ability test.

- 10. Other unfinished matters are subject to the compilation of the University Admissions Admissions Guide and the relevant regulations of the University.
- 11. These requirements are adopted by the Admissions Committee meeting and sent to the department meeting for implementation. The same applies to the amendment.
