

Foreign Student Application for Admission, Department of Bioresources, DaYeh University

Adopted by the department meeting on April 02, 2013
The revised by the department meeting on November 11, 2014

1. According to the regulation 7 of the "Admission Requirements for Foreign Students of DaYeh University", the Department has established the "Regulations for Selection and Admission of Foreign Students in the Department of Bioresources, DaYeh University".
2. The term “selection and admission” as used in the Regulations refers to the applicant's individual application, and the department examines the applicant's admission qualification. Those who qualified the examination will be sent to the Academic Affairs Office for verification, and the admission permit will be issued.
3. These requirements are reviewed by the Department's Admissions Committee, and the relevant selection methods, procedures and scoring regulations are set out and handled carefully after being announced in the school.
4. In accordance with these requirements, the individual application for admission to the school shall be handled in accordance with the principles of just, fairness and openness, and the relevant confidentiality and avoidance principles shall be carefully formulated.
5. The years of study, enrollment quotas, and eligibility for foreign students shall be handled in accordance with the provisions of the Admission Requirements for Foreign Students of DaYeh University.
6. The procedures:
 - a. the first stage (Application documents to be submitted)

Students applying for admission to the University should prepare the relevant documents and apply in advance of the application deadline of the Admissions Guide.

The relevant documents should be prepared in accordance with the “Foreign Student Admissions Guide”.
 - b. the second stage (Department of Admissions Committee)

The Department of Admissions Committee, according to the application documents, convened the "International Student Selection Conference" for foreign students to apply for admission qualification examination.

The principle of merit-based admission is adopted. Those who qualified the examination are sent to the Academic Affairs Office for verification, and the admission permit must be issued.
7. Other unfinished matters are subject to the compilation of the foreign student enrollment brochure and the relevant regulations of the school.
8. The Regulations shall be adopted by the Admissions Committee meeting, sent to the Department of Conferences for approval, and reported to the Academic Affairs Office and Office of Foreign Affairs for future reference. The same applies to the amendment.
